

Call for two research grants in the lipoprotein(a) research field

The Austrian Atherosclerosis Society (AAS) announces **2 research grants** with the amount of € **9,000 each** for projects in the field of lipoprotein(a) research. These funds are exclusively intended for the support of junior scientists.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Scientific staff at Austrian public sector research institutions
- Age maximum is 35 years (exceptions: part-time parental leave for family reasons with e.g. max. 2 years per child)

Submission of applications: Applications must be submitted in English and meet the following formal requirements:

- Description of the project divided into abstract, background, aim of the study, methods, schedule and budget with justification. Length: max. 5 pages (excluding title page and references), Arial font, font size 11, line spacing 1.5; margins at least 2.5 cm.
- With regard to the budget, please note that overhead/cost reimbursements cannot be paid to the respective institution.
- If the submitted project exceeds € 9,000, a confirmation must be provided of how the portion in excess of €9,000 will be funded.
- Curriculum vitae including a list of publications (the three most important highlighted in bold)

Procedure:

- Deadline for submission: March 31, 2023. Applications received after this date will not be considered.
- Applications will be reviewed by a panel of experts.
- Winners will be notified by the end of April 2023.
- The fellowship certificates will be presented at the AAS meeting in St. Gilgen on May 12/13, 2023.
